### REGULATIONS

- Vehicles / trailers must have a daily or annual boat launch permit. Parking for all tournaments is the gravel parking area between the fish cleaning station and the band shell. No parking on the grass. **If tournament participants plan to purchase an annual permit please encourage them to do so early enough so the permits can be mailed and received prior to the event.**
- Organizer is responsible for ensuring all trash and event materials are appropriately removed or disposed of properly; including trash and materials in the overflow parking area and all areas used for event activities. Trash that cannot be contained in receptacles provided at the facility must be hauled away.
- Organizer is responsible for ensuring fish cleaning station is left in a clean and sanitary condition from fish tournament activities.
- Tournament must abide by all local codes and ordinances; including but not limited to marine safety, noise, disorderly conduct, alcohol, and peddlers licenses.
- Tournament organizers and participants cannot monopolize or block the public from using the boat ramps / docks, fish cleaning station, or other facilities generally available for public use at the site.
