## City Council Vacancy

*The City of Montague is seeking candidates to fill a vacancy on the City Council for the remainder of the 4-year term ending November 2020. If you are interested in being considered for the appointment please submit a letter of interest and file a biography questionnaire with the City Clerk. City Council meets on the first and third Monday of the month.*

## Home Improvement

If you're planning a home improvement project (deck, fence, shed, siding, bathroom upgrade, water heater, etc.) know the rules and regulations that apply to your project.

Make sure you apply for and obtain any necessary permits (zoning and/or building) before any work begins. The following are a few basic questions to consider before getting started:

- ⇒ Do I know my property lines?
- ⇒ Do I know the required setbacks?
- ⇒ Do I know the building, plumbing, mechanical, and electrical requirements for my project?
- ⇒ Do I need a permit from the City?

## Brush Pick Up

The City of Montague will offer brush pick up the **week of May 21st**. Materials must be placed roadside before Monday, May 21st as only one trip will be made through town.

All materials must be placed near the edge of the street and should not be more than four inches (4") in diameter. No stumps, branches, or logs created by property owners removing mature trees will be collected. In addition, no materials created by commercial trimming, building / construction materials, or other debris will be collected.

Brush generated after this can be brought to the White Lake Area Solid Waste Authority (2100 Holton-Whitehall Road) and disposed of according to their fee schedule.
