Plastic 1-4 labeled on the bottom of product

Wash Clean and dry

Acceptable Plastics

Milk Jugs

Water Bottles

Laundry Detergents Bottles

Coffee Containers

Yogurt Cups

Butter and Margarine\Tubs

Glass

Clear and Colored Food and Beverage Glass (Washed Clean)

No Lids left on Jars

Cardboard

All cardboard must be flattened

Corrugated Cardboard from Shipping, packing, and moving.

Cereal boxes, tubes from paper towel and toilet paper, etc.

THINGS THAT CANNOT BE RECYCLED

Any food container that has food in it

Anything that had hazardous materials (motor oil, pesticides, medical waste, and gases)

Anything stringy or tubing (hoses, tubing, pipes, and packing straps)
