

HISTORIC BUILDING FUNDRAISER

Help save this historic building within the City of Montague's Oak Grove Cemetery. Erected in 1920, the City is working to save and protect this 103 year-old local landmark. In order to preserve the building the City is making significant repairs to the structure over the next couple years and is in need of your financial support to help preserve this building for the next 103 years!

A receiving vault is being erected as the Montague cemetery, the urgent need which has long been felt, especially during severe winter weather when the immediate burial of bodies is a most difficult task. The building is being financed by the Ladies Cemetery Improvement Association which has long contemplated this important addition to our cemetery, and it has been greatly beautified and improved since the ladies took a hand in it. The new building will cost in the neighborhood of \$1700.
